NOTIFICATION

No. F.2(3)/Fin (E-I)/2003-04/(ii)/135 - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (2 of 1899) read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification S.O. 1726/ No.F.2/5/61-Jud.II dated the 22nd July, 1961, the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi is pleased to reduce the stamp duty to three percent in respect of conveyance on sale in cases of the purchase of immovable property by women, either individually or severally. The stamp duty shall stand accordingly reduced on instruments of Agreement to Sell also in such class of cases.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect and shall extend to the whole of the National Capital Territory of Delhi.
